



Scenario ECHO

Scenario FIREFLY

What do you do next?

Scenario BLUEJAY

You are a Trip Leader with a group of 30 elementary school students in Riverview Park. Today's activity is geocaching. About halfway through the course, a rabid dog is on the loose in the park. You notice the dog chase after one of the groups.

What do you do next?

Scenario GREEN GRAPE

You are a Trip Leader for a fishing outing at the North Shore (right outside of PNC Park). About 20 middle school students from a summer camp join the fishing outing. You and your assistant work to give the kids bait, rods, and set them up to fish. After about 20 minutes of fishing, you hear a girl scream. She runs up to her teacher, then they both come to you: one of the students has "Hooked" this girl's eye (they were casting their rod and the hook got in her eye).

What do you do next?

Scenario WAM BAM APPLE JAM

You and your assistant Trip Leader are biking with a group of 12 youth along the Three Rivers Heritage Trail. Someone stops you along the ride to inform you that one of your participants was heard "shouting" at another biker on the trail. You and your assistant were not aware of this/did not hear anything unusual. You're not sure which student was responsible for the "shouting" either.
